Dear Good Shepherd Ohana:

It's hard to believe that 2021 is almost over (as I write) and that the time has come for me to wish you a Happy New Year for 2022. I look forward to the coming year to see how things will unfold for us as we continue to pray that we will emerge from this pandemic.

As I write this letter, it is only the second week of Advent, but when you receive this message, we will be looking toward the end of Christmas, the beginning of Epiphany, and soon after the beginning of Lent. For Lent I hope to have an offering for all of you around the Stations of the Cross and I will have more news to share about that in the February newsletter.



Please know how grateful I am to all of you for your pledge commitments for 2022. Today, we have almost \$140,000 in pledge commitments, compared to about \$120,000 last year. This will help us keep church operations going as we make necessary maintenance and repairs to our commercial properties; some of that work has already begun. We hope to have all our commercial properties rented out by the middle of 2022.

The 2022 Annual Meeting of the parish is set for Sunday, January 23 immediately after the 9 AM service is complete. I am required to give everyone two weeks written notice and this communiqué is meant to serve as that notice.

This is also the opportune time to let you know that Lani Scott will be retiring from Good Shepherd at the end of December after many years of service to the congregation as its bookkeeper. I would like to thank Lani for her tireless commitment and dedication to Good Shepherd. Beginning January 2022, we are going to outsource our bookkeeping to a company in Wisconsin called ICON.

Finally, I would like to close this month's letter with a word of thanks for everyone who joined our nightly Compline services during Advent, as well as to everyone who made the broadcast of those services possible.

I close here with warm thoughts and best wishes for a continued Blessed Advent and a very Merry Christmas.
