Dear Good Shepherd Ohana:

We are now coming into the season of Lent, the time of year where we sit with Jesus in the desert for 40 days.

When I was a kid, all of my Roman Catholic classmates (of which there were many) and my teachers talked about what they were giving up for Lent and all of them abstained from eating meat on Fridays, although eating fish was OK. In later years I learned that the sacrifice was a way of becoming more in touch with the presence of God.



I know that this is a time-honored tradition and I don't want to discount it. At the same time, it has never been part of my Lenten practice to give something up. Instead, I'd like to take something on. This year it will be preparing daily morning reflections for the congregation on the Stations of the Cross. They will launch at 6 AM every morning from Ash Wednesday through the Saturday before Palm Sunday.

Another thing that I would like us all to consider taking on is intentional prayer, especially for the situation with the border with the Ukraine and Russia. That will not only bring us closer to the presence of God, but will also help us discern what a loving God would have us do in a situation like this.

And simultaneous to these two things, I think it would be helpful to think about what we are grateful for. Every single day in the midst of the COVID-19 pandemic, I have felt a sense of joy because of my personal sense of gratitude about being with all of you. I'm also grateful for my wife and the way that my life has changed since we got married. I think these things are important to bear in mind as we navigate challenges like COVID-19, because it keeps us going. So, take time to be grateful for whatever gifts God has stowed upon you and your families and if we can do that together, I think it will be a blessed and holy Lent for all of us.

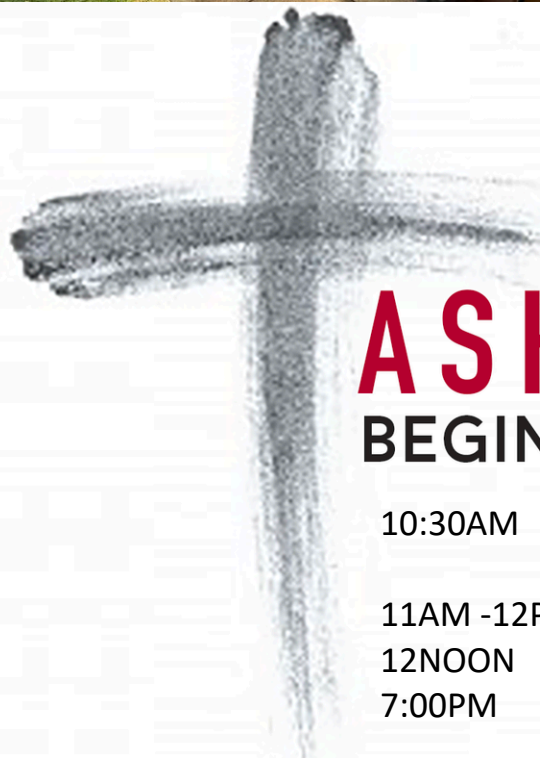

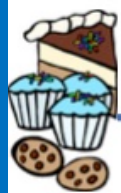

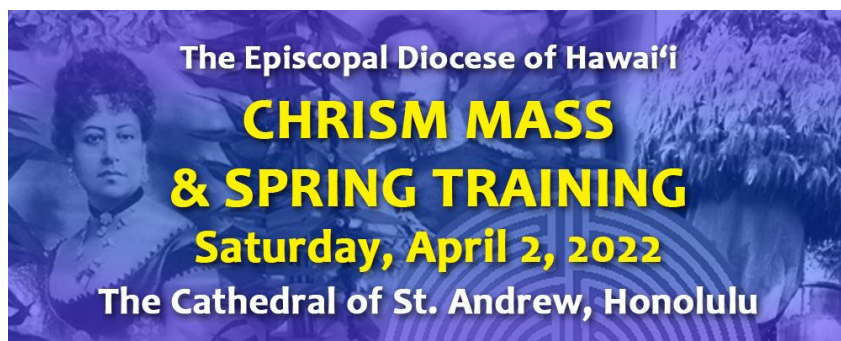
